

Auto-evaluation - auto-evaluation missions / pre-evaluation visits.

SIS / SIRENE

In order to organise the future Schengen evaluation mission in the field, in the best conditions, between 20-24 July 2010, a SIS/SIRENE pre-evaluation visit took place with support from Austrian and German experts.

Between 30.06-01.07.2009 , the visit of TAIEX experts took place in Bucharest in order to present the solution of SISone4ALL, as an alternative solution for the interconnection of the national system of Romania to C-SIS.

According to the procedures established at EU level regarding the Schengen evaluation process, Romania started the auto-evaluation towards the preparation for implementing the Schengen acquis.

The Schengen questionnaire was disseminated among all the institutions involved, the answers were analyzed and measures towards improving the situation have been taken.

In order to prepare the Schengen evaluation process and to get the structures involved accustomed with this process, auto-evaluation missions have been organized.

Borders.

Between 01 - 05 April 2007 the first auto-evaluation mission has been organized at the Border Police Directorate in Iasi

Between 20-25 August 2007 a new auto-evaluation mission regarding the situation of the international airports and ports, took place in Constanta.

In 18 October 2007 an auto-evaluation mission regarding the situation of Henri Coanda airport took place

13 November 2007 an auto-evaluation mission regarding the situation of Aurel Vlaicu airport took place

Between 20 - 27 January 2008 an auto-evaluation mission in the field of border control took place at Radauti Border Police Directorate.

Between 28 September- 3rd October 2008 an auto evaluation mission in the field of border control and surveillance took place at Iasi Border Police Directorate, with support of Lithuanian expert.

Between 20-24th October 2008 an auto evaluation mission in the field of border control and surveillance took place at Ruse Border Police Directorate, in Bulgarian Republic, with support of German experts. At this mission, Romanian experts participate as invited.

between 30-31 March 2009- a pre-evaluation mission in the field of air borders was organised with TAIEX support at the Henri Coanda Airoport;

between 11-15 October 2009- a pre-evaluation mission in the field of land borders control and surveillance took place at Satu Mare , Maramures, Suceava, Botosani, and Iasi counties organised with the TAIEX support;

between 15-19 February 2010- a pre-evaluation in the field of land borders control and surveillance took place at Suceava, Botosani, Iasi and Vaslui counties;

between 01-04 March 2010 – a mission for preparing the Schengen visit of Romania in the field of land borders at Suceava, Botosani, Iasi and Vaslui counties;

between 17-19 March 2010- a mission for preparing of the Schengen visit of Romania in the field of land borders at Timis and Mehedinti counties.

Data protection

between 15-16 January 2009 a pre-evaluation visit in the field of data protection took place in Bucharest.

Between 11-12 December 2008 the seminar „Data protection for police and judicial cooperation in criminal matters: EU requirements” organised by TAIEX in co-operation with ERA took place at Bucharest”. A number of aprox 300 participants within MIAR, NSAPDP and Ministry of Justice had participated to this seminar.

Between 10 -11 September 2007 a pre-evaluation visit in the field of data protection took place.

Police cooperation

Between 24-28 September 2007 an auto-evaluation mission in the field of police cooperation took place

Between 20 - 27 January 2008 an auto-evaluation mission in the field of police cooperation took place at Suceava County Police Inspectorate and Maramures County Police Inspectorate.

Romanian experts participated in evaluation visits deployed in the 9 member states who joined the EU in 2004 and then accessed to the Schengen Area in December 2007.

Between 18-23 February 2007, a Romanian expert participated in the Schengen evaluation mission in the field of maritime and air borders in Malta, as a member of the evaluation team.

Between 27 August-3 September 2007, a Romanian expert participated, as an observer, to the evaluation mission in the field of visas, in Tripoli/ Libia.

Between 17-28 September, 2 Romanian experts participated, as observers, in SIS/SIRENE evaluations mission in Poland, Malta, Czech Republic, Malta, Slovenia, Hungary and Slovakia.

Visas

between 3-4 July 2008 the first auto-evaluation mission in the field of visas took place at Consulate of Romania from Moscow (Russian Federation)

in 24 July 2008 a new auto-evaluation mission in the field of visas took place at Consulate of Romania from Belgrad (Serbia)

in 1 August 2008 an auto-evaluation mission in the field of visas took place at Consulate of Romania from Kishinev (Moldova)

between 7-8 May 2009 an auto-evaluation mission in the field of visas took place at Consulate of Romania from Kishinev (Moldova), organised by TAIEX, with the participation of 2 experts from Austria and Hungary

in 18 May 2009 an auto-evaluation mission in the field of visas took place at Consulate of Romania from Istanbul (Turkey), organised by TAIEX, with the participation of 2 experts from Austria and Hungary
